Dear Supporters of the Epilepsy Foundation of Arizona,

Our Foundation’s focus in Fiscal Year 2016-2017 was to increase the number of individuals we touched in our quest to educate and train regarding epilepsy throughout Arizona. The following provides a synopsis of our accomplishments:

- The Foundation provided direct services to over 1755 individuals with, or affected by, epilepsy.
- Social media: Facebook-3726; Instagram-2322; Twitter-732
- Sixty-two volunteers committed their time, so we could utilize their valuable talents.
- Camp Candlelight was enjoyed by 47 children who learned about their seizures and positive coping skills, while reveling in fun camp activities. Six campers transitioned to Counselors-in-Training this year.
- Our events attracted 1031 participants. This does not count the individuals who came to support us at our 5K event who did not register.
- We trained 323 school personnel and first responders so they can now identify seizures, administer appropriate first aid, and determine when a seizure is an emergency.
- Raising awareness of epilepsy and our Foundation services was promoted through 13 tablings at various venues.
